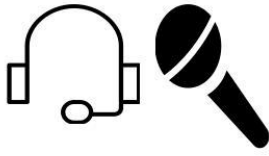

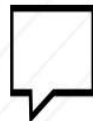

Category of Grades

**TYPES OF ASSESSMENTS**  
 Major Assessments: 30 points  
 Minor Assessments: 20 points  
 Homework: 10 points



Wait...What?  
 Every assignment you receive will be under a certain category: interpretive reading, interpretive listening, presentational, or interpersonal. Every quarter, you will get a grade for each category.

Example:  
 interpretive reading: 96%  
 interpretive listening: 93%  
 Presentational: 90%  
 Interpersonal: 91%

So your final quarter grade: 92.5%
